

- 1. REGISTER AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE. SOME CAMPS FILL QUICKLY. REGISTRATIONS ARE PROCESSED IN THE ORDER OF THEIR ARRIVAL.
- 2. **REGISTER ONLINE** AT BAYSHORECAMP.ORG/REGISTER OR USE THE REGISTRATION FORM PROVIDED IN THIS BROCHURE.
- 3. THESE FORMS CAN ALSO BE FOUND AND PRINTED FROM OUR WEBSITE.
- 4. INDICATE YOUR CHURCH'S NAME AND CITY. CAMPERS WHO DO NOT HAVE A HOME CHURCH MAY LEAVE THIS LINE BLANK.
- 5. REGISTER YOUR CAMPER FOR THE APPROPRIATE AGE GROUP AS DETERMINED BY HIS OR HER SCHOOL GRADE IN THE FALL.
- 6. IF YOUR CAMPER HAS A HANDICAP THAT MAY AFFECT STAFFING REQUIREMENTS OR ACCOMODATIONS, PLEASE CALL THE CAMP OFFICE BEFORE SUBMITTING HIS OR HER REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT.
