ELECTIVES

Songwriting: Learn to write a song from beginning to end. We will develop the skills to create a great musical progression, catchy melody and powerful lyrics. We hope to both write songs together and allow space for individual songwriting as well. This elective will also allow space for recording our original songs right at camp and we will show you how you might record your songs right from home. Bring journals, lyrics or poems, instruments and let's start writing! Human Video: We will be combining music, dance, drama and movements to express our message to one of our program songs. I have ideas, you have ideas, and together we will build our human video.

Journaling: Explore the pages of scripture with color and imagination! This year's Bible journaling elective will allow you to use different art tools in order to bring scripture to life. This will be a great way to spend time with God using your creative gifts and skills.

Guitar/Ukelele/Bass: Whether you have been playing guitar since you could tie your own shoes, or you've never played before, this is the place to take your skill to a new level.

Spoken Word: Poetry is a beautiful thing, not only can it give us a glimpse of ones life, feelings and thoughts, it can also help us communicate important messages. Threre is not a message more important than the Word of God. Learn to relevantly and effectively communicate the Gospel through the art of Spoken Word Poetry.

Worship Sign Language: Learning signs for some common words in worship songs, and learning one song in its entirety to perform at the end of the week program.

God's Word-ALIVE and APPLICABLE: This elective will give you some specific study tools to make your Bible reading come alive as you apply it to your daily life. We will be digging into a portion of scripture using these tools.
